TO ALL AUSTRALIAN CROQUET AND MALLETSPORTS CLUBS AND THEIR MEMBERS

The 2013 Australian Gateball Championship will be held at Croquet Victoria Headquarters, Cairnlea 11 – 13 October 2013. Gateball comes under the umbrella of the ACA.

I invite all clubs to participate in this gateball event, either by playing or taking the opportunity to learn this exciting team game. The ball skills required for playing gateball and croquet are the same.

Gateball is a growing mallet sport in Australia. There are over 20 clubs, from ACT, NSW, Queensland and Victoria now regularly playing the game. Gateball is played by 10 million people worldwide. There are many international competitions and a World Championship every 4 years. At the 2010 World Championship, held in China, 13 countries were represented – 93 teams in all, including 5 from Australia.

This will be the seventh Australian Gateball Championship and the second held at Cairnlea. As well as our domestic teams we also expect, as in the past, international participation to continue.

EVENT INFORMATION

Event:	Held every two years, the Australian Gateball Championship is Australia's premier gateball event. In 2013, the event will be held at Cairnlea, Melbourne, Victoria, for the second time. Teams from Australia and around the world are expected to attend. We look forward to seeing you there!

Venue:	Croquet Victoria Headquarters 65 Noble Banks Drive Cairnlea VIC 3023		
Eligibility:	Each team must have a manager and five to eight players. The manager may be one of the players. Australian teams – players from interstate teams must be affiliated with their state croquet association.		
	International teams – players must be affiliated with either their nation croquet or gateball organisation.		
Number of teams:	The competition will be limited to 32 teams. Applications will be processed on a first-come-first-served basis. Team managers will be notified if their nomination has been successful.		
Equipment:	Gateball courts will be prepared with gates, balls and scoreboards. Players shall provide their own sticks and bibs/player number identification.		
Rules:	Matches will be played under the World Gateball Union rules current at the time of the tournament.		
Referees:	All matches will be conducted with a referee. All teams will have refereeing duties.		

- Match format:Matches will be played in one or more block draws with a final series
compromising a grand final and semi finals depending on the number of
blocks. Final details will be available when the numbers of entries is known.
The Event Manager will decide the final format. Matches will be of 30
minutes duration in accordance with the Rules of Gateball.
- **Dress code:** Teams are required to wear a uniform. As a minimum, this includes matching shirts and similar pants. A combination of long-sleeve and short-sleeve shirts and long and short pants is acceptable.

Inclement weather: The Event Manager reserves the right to change the format of play and make such other changes as may be necessary in the event of inclement weather.

- **Entry Fee:** AUD\$160 per team non-refundable. Cheques/money orders should be made playable to the Australian Croquet Association.
- **Entries Close:** Entry forms must be received by the Event Manager by 9 September 2013.
