GATEBALL REFEREE

What you need to know and do to become an accredited gateball referee -

You must be over the age of sixteen.

Complete the Australian Sports Commissions online course –"Community Officiating General Principles" and receive your certificate on line."

Read and understand the book "Official Gateball Rules Guide for Referees -2015".

Level 2.

Perform referee duties at club level for one year and have assisted in at least two games at championships..

Apply in writing/email to the Director of Gateball Refereeing, confirming eligibility. Your application must be endorsed by your club.

Sit for the theory examination at the advised venue and date. It is a closed book exam with no time limit for completion. The pass rate is 70%.

The next practical exam will be conducted at the Qld State Championships.

Level 1.

You need to have been a level 2 referee for one year and have refereed in at least two games in state championships as well as assisting in two games at national championships.

You must have completed the online ASC course above.

Apply in writing/email to the Director of Gateball Refereeing, confirming eligibility.

Sit for the theory examination at the advised venue and date. It is a closed book exam with a time limit of one and a half hours. The pass rate is 75%.

Failure.

You may reapply and sit the exam again six months later at the advised venue and date.

Re-accreditation.

Any gateball referee previously accredited is now required to complete the ASC online course "Community Officiating General Principles".

You must also complete an activity card providing evidence of updating knowledge and interpretation of current rules, officiating at events and demonstrating competence as a referee.

Fees – There are no fees required for gateball exams.
