through the gate, can be easily confirmed.

Matches will be played in a 'Round Robin' or 'Block Draw' format. Final details shall be **Match Format:** 

available when the number of entries is known. The CAQ Event Coordinator, Tournament Mannager and Venue Tournament Manager in consultation with the State Gateball Director will decide the final format and any changes thereafter due to weather or other conditions.
