Trains from Sydney Airport to Sydney's Central Station can connect with trains to Gosford. The nearby interchange has buses to EDSACC and on to the Entrance. Airport shuttles may also be able to be booked.

With an average October temperature of just below 20°C on the Central Coast in October, it will be a perfect time to visit and enjoy some gateball.
