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Conditions of Play for the Sunshine Coast Masters and Apprentices Gateball Tournament

Saturday 12th, Sunday 13th, Monday 14th November 2022

The event/s shall be played in accordance with the Official Gateball Rules and Guide for Referees (2019) as published by the World Gateball Union and in keeping with the ACA Rules and Regulations.

Eligibility: All players must be affiliated with their State Croquet Association.

1. Teams must have at least 5 players and a maximum of 8, which may include a Manager and/or a nonplaying captain. Teams can represent one club or be formed from any number of clubs.
2. Doubles combinations may represent 1 club or be formed from 2 different clubs.
3. Competitions to be played in Round Robin or Block format, depending on the number of entries.
4. All games shall be conducted with a referee. Teams will be required to assist with referee and associated duties.
5. Team Managers/Captains to be available for coin toss and team member nominations 5 (five) minutes prior to start of each game at nominated lawn.
6. Courts will be equipped with gates, balls and scoreboards. Players are required to supply their own sticks and numbered bibs.
7. Teams are required to wear a uniform, flat-soled covered sports shoes and a hat. Doubles players to wear matching shirts and pants.
8. The Tournament Manager has the final decision concerning all matters affecting the running of the events. All decisions of Tournament Manager and Tournament Referee will be final.
9. Gateball Australia Default Forfeit Procedure will apply to any forfeited games.

Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded to Winners and Runners-up.

Closing date for Nominations 31st October, 2022
